



# The Bethlem and Maudsley Hospital School

## Primary and Middle Education

**Who do we work with?** We work with pupils aged 7 to 12.

**Who works here?** We have a small staff of experienced, caring teachers and Teaching Assistants.

**Where do you learn?** The school is very close to Acorn Lodge. It takes two minutes to walk to school! We have two large coloured classrooms and a well-equipped Art room. There are two class groups and class size varies from 3 – 6 pupils. There are also opportunities to learn in a larger group when the two classes come together for assembly, drama and swimming.



**When do you learn?** Timetables vary according to the need of the pupil. Some pupils need an individualised programme which might mean working on the ward or coming in to school for specific sessions. Our school times are 10 – 12 am and 1 – 3 pm. We work closely with the hospital staff to ensure there is the right balance between getting better and continuing to learn.

**What is on the timetable?** We follow the national curriculum and teach Maths, English, Science, Computing, History, Geography, RE, Art, Music, Design and Technology, PE, Drama. The children also get the chance to do Pottery and some go horse-riding once a week.



All work is personalised to meet the learning needs of the pupil. With your permission, we liaise closely with pupils' schools to ensure we can share information about past and present achievements or strategies that help.

**What resources do we have?** At the Bethlem site we are surrounded by woodland and have access to a large playing field. We regularly update our resources which include:

- Well-resourced classrooms.
- Extensive computing equipment which include laptops, ipads and interactive whiteboards.
- A wide range of exciting fiction and non-fiction books, reading schemes and DVD's.
- Art and Design and Technology materials.
- Access to the pottery workshop.
- A range of activities to encourage and support social skills.
- Resources for learners with special educational needs.
- Visits from museums providing workshops.
- Guinea pigs and a rabbit to stroke and care for.

**How do we monitor your progress?** Our pupils have an Individual Education Plan which includes key targets for you to work on. These are usually of mixture of targets for learning and for helping you to feel good about yourself and getting on with other people.
